Privacy Policy:

The Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry respects your online privacy and does not sell or rent your personal information to third parties for marketing purposes at any time or for any reason.

Organization & Mission:

The Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry is a non-profit, faith-based organization which provides food assistance to families and individuals. The pantry currently serves residents of six contiguous communities – Allen Park, Brownstown Township, Dearborn Heights, Romulus, Southgate, and Taylor. Our larger mission is to insure that no one goes hungry in the Downriver area and that those in need are served with the dignity they deserve.

Donations/Contributions:

All contributions are made with the understanding that the Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry has complete control over the use and administration of the donated funds. All contributions to the Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry are deductible for income tax purposes - IRS Section 501(c)(3). All financial contributions are in U.S. dollars.

Security:

To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online, in compliance with the Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standard. Your information is transmitted on servers located in the United States, and your data and your personal information are protected against unauthorized access and disclosure.

This Web site takes every precaution to protect our users' information. When users submit sensitive information via the Web site, their information is protected both online and off-line. When our donation form asks users to enter sensitive information (such as credit card number), that information is encrypted and is protected with the best encryption software in the industry - SSL. While we use SSL encryption to protect

sensitive information online, we also do everything in our power to protect user-information off-line. All of our users' information, not just the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in our offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to personally identifiable information.

Third Party Intermediaries:

The Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry uses an outside company to process your donations, and a credit card processing company to bill users for donations. These companies do not retain, share, store or use personally identifiable information for any secondary purposes.

Links:

The Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry provides links to other web sites as a resource for donors who are interested further information or additional giving opportunities. We encourage you to view their privacy policies as well. Any information you share with these web sites is subject to their policies and practices and is independent of the Fish & Loaves Community Food Pantry.

Log Files:

Like most standard Web site servers we use log files. This includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp, and number of clicks to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses, etc. are not linked to personally identifiable information.
